As I expect many of you are aware, Governor Cooper has declared a State of Emergency for North Carolina in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. All citizens have been asked to take certain measures, consistent with public health and medical guidelines, designed to limit and mitigate the transmission of and exposure to COVID-19. Among those steps includes minimizing large gatherings of people and practicing social distancing.
